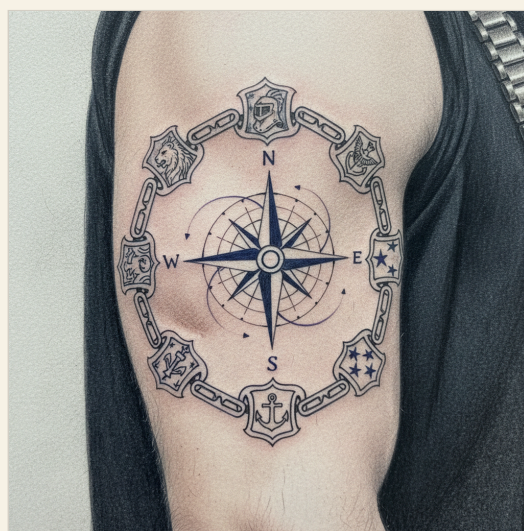
Design elements:
